### **EAST AYRSHIRE COMMUNITY PLANNING RESIDENTS' SURVEY 2017**

East Ayrshire Community Planning Partners (East Ayrshire Council, NHS Ayrshire and Arran, Police Scotland, the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service, the Ayrshire College, Scottish Enterprise, Skills Development Scotland, Strathclyde Partnership for Transport, the voluntary sector, the business community through Ayrshire Chamber of Commerce, and the community) have engaged Research Resource to conduct a Residents' Survey, interviewing 2,000 residents, from Mid-June to August 2017.

The purpose of the Residents' Survey is to gain an increased understanding of local priorities and views of residents on public service provision/satisfaction and provide a comparison with surveys carried out in 2005, 2008, 2011 and 2014.

There will be a limited pilot survey exercise on **Tuesday 13 June 2017** and the full survey fieldwork exercise will be rolled out across all communities from week commencing **Monday 19 June 2017 for 9 weeks ending Friday 18 August 2017**.

All **Research Resource** interviewers will have photographic ID Badges for the duration of the survey period. They will also have an introductory letter detailing the nature of the work that they are undertaking on behalf of the Community Planning Partnership and people being interviewed will be able to call either East Ayrshire Council on 01563 576075 or Research Resource on 0141 641 6410 to confirm that the interviewer is legitimate.

Face to Face recruitment of a Residents' Panel of 1,000 will be taking place in tandem with the Residents' Survey. Signing up to become a Panel member gives residents an opportunity to play a part in shaping the future of East Ayrshire's communities and influencing the decisions which are taken by local Community Planning Partners.
